Arkangelos takes its name from the Greek Orthodox text which Ivan Moody set for The Hilliard Ensemble in 1989. The programme encompasses Christian music from several different countries and as many different centuries. As well as exploring traditional forms of music from Armenia, 13th century France and Italy and 16th century England the programme also celebrates the Ensemble's continuing relationship with several living composers - Arvo Pärt (Estonia), Vache Sharafyan (Armenia), Katia Tchemberdji and Alexander Raskatov (Russia).
